Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Diane M. Quinlan, (Position #9U632, appropriation #02-20-201010-2621-013-500132), as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary of \$98,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or January 17, 2020, whichever is later, for a term ending July 1, 2024.

EXPLANATION

Ms. Quinlan is a resident of Merrimack. She earned her Bachelor of Arts from the College of the Holy Cross in 1984 and her Juris Doctor from Suffolk University Law School in 1990. She was a law clerk for Judge Martin F. Loughlin of the U.S. District Court for the District of New Hampshire from 1990 to 1991. She practiced law as an Associate at Conley, Haley, O'Neil and Kaplan in Bath, Maine from 1991 to 1992 and at Rath, Young, Pignatelli and Oyer in Concord from 1992 to 1995. She was a Shareholder at Devine, Millimet and Branch in Manchester from 1995 to 2004. Ms. Quinlan was Chancellor and General Counsel for the Diocese of Manchester from 2004 to 2019. She joined the Department of Justice as Assistant Director of the Charitable Trust Unit in August 2019. I am requesting that Ms. Quinlan receive a \$7,227.50 salary increase, from \$90,772.50 to \$98,000. I plan to continue her assignment in the Charitable Trust Unit. A copy of her resume is attached.

2001 Laws of NH Chapter 158 amended RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) to provide that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
