REQUESTED ACTION

The Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, State Library respectfully requests permission to award a Conservation License Plate (Moose Plate) Grant to the Town of Farmington (VC #177387) in the amount of \$10,000 for Late 1800s Invoice Records Preservation effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through December 31, 2019. 100% Agency Income

EXPLANATION

Pursuant to RSA 261:97-c, Conservation Number Plate Funds are used to promote the use and conservation of cultural resources in New Hampshire and to preserve the cultural heritage that belongs to all New Hampshire citizens by providing for the conservation and preservation of significant publicly-owned documents.

In recent years, the town of Farmington has been working to preserve its historic documents and record books. These records, which are required by state law to be preserved (RSA 41:58-59), contain a great deal of valuable information for town residents and officials, historians, and family researchers. This Moose Plate grant will specifically be used to restore and protect three volumes of 19th century invoice records. The Town's Invoice Record Books contain records of all town properties, ownership, value and taxes from 1884 to 1901. The loss or destruction of any of these volumes would represent a significant loss of vital historical records to the town. Grant money will be used to repair and protect the original volumes and to create archival microfilm copies for the State Library and the Division of Archives & Records Management.

The Attorney General's office has approved the grant agreement as to form, substance and execution.

This agreement between the State of New Hampshire, Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, New Hampshire State Library (hereinafter "State Library") and the town of Farmington, New Hampshire (hereinafter "Grantee") is to witness receipt of funds subject to the following conditions.

- 1. FUNDING PERIOD: State of New Hampshire Fiscal Year 2018/2019
- 2. OBLIGATION OF THE GRANTEE
 - 2.1.1.The Grantee agrees to accept \$10,000.00 and apply the funds to the project entitled Late 1800s Invoice Records Preservation as described in the Grantee's FY 2018/2019 Moose License Plate Conservation Grant application and budget. In the performance of this grant agreement the Grantee is in all respects an independent contractor and is neither an agent nor employee of the State.
 - 2.1.2.The Grantee agrees to abide by the limitations, conditions and procedures outlined herein and to perform grant activities as outlined in its grant application and project budget. If appropriated funds for this grant program are reduced or terminated (including a reduction by the NH Conservation License Plate Advisory Committee), all payments under this grant may cease. That determination rests within the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Natural and Cultural Resources.
- 3. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Funding credit must appear in all programs, publicity, and promotional materials. The following wording is suggested.

"This preservation project has been made possible through funds received from the sale of the New Hampshire Moose Conservation License Plate and administered by the New Hampshire State Library, a division of the New Hampshire Department of Natural and Cultural Resources."

- 4. PAYMENT: Payment will be made upon the acceptance of this grant agreement in the amount of ninety percent (90%) and in the amount of ten percent (10%) upon the acceptance of final grant reports.
- 5. FINAL GRANT REPORTS: The Grantee agrees to submit final narrative and financial reports on a form provided by the State Library by **December 31, 2019**. Failure to submit final reports will render the Grantee ineligible for future Conservation License Plate Grant funding within the NH Department of Natural and Cultural Resources.

6. SOVERIGN IMMUNITY: No provision of this contract is to be deemed a waiver of sovereign immunity by the State of New Hampshire.
