

Requested Action

Authorize the Department of Safety (DOS), Division of State Police, to **retroactively** accept and expend \$35,224.00 from the Department of Safety, Office of Highway Safety, titled NHSP Distracted Driving Patrols, for the purpose of encouraging all motor vehicle operators to focus on the task of driving. Effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period of July 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017. Funding Source: 100% Agency Income.

Explanation

This item is **retroactive** due to the need for additional time to reconcile the payroll transactions associated with this grant. The Troopers conducting these details are subject to a "garcia" pay cycle, which increases the complexity of the payroll calculations and, therefore, necessitates the need for added reviews when compiling grant information. These federal pass-through funds will be used to hire, on an off-duty basis, currently employed State Police troopers to conduct distracted driving patrols throughout the State, with a focus on high traffic count and crash locations. These patrols will be conducted in an effort to encourage motorists to focus their full attention on driving safely and to refrain from using hand-held devices while driving. This will be done in conjunction with the use of statewide Electronic Message Board system (EMB's) and other media outlets to inform the motoring public that the law prohibiting the use of hand-held devices while driving will be strictly enforced.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Funds in Class 18, Overtime, are needed to pay the overtime for details as approved by the approving Federal Agency.

Funds in Class 40, Indirect Costs, are needed to pay the indirect cost on the remaining appropriations.

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Additional funds in Class 60, Benefits, are needed to pay for benefits associated with the overtime for the details as approved by the approving Federal Agency.

In the event that Agency Income funds become no longer available General and/or Highway funds will not be requested to support this program.
