EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 93 - 4

an order establishing an alternative administrative entity for National and Community Service Trust Act of 1993.

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire is committed to engaging all of its citizens in meaningful service that meets local needs; and

WHEREAS, the New Hampshire Private Industry Council, Inc. has experienced success in delivering service through various projects; and

WHEREAS, the National and Community Service Trust Act of 1993 requires that states establish service commissions or an alternative administrative entity to carry out the responsibilities of this national program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEPHEN MERRILL, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Part 2, Article 41 of the New Hampshire Constitution, do hereby order and direct the following:

- I. The New Hampshire Job Training Industry Council, Inc. (herein called the "Council") is hereby designated the alternative administrative entity for the National Community Service Trust Act activities.
- II. The charge to the Private Industry Council is to establish policies, provide administrative oversight and promote programs that strengthen the service ethic among the state's citizens by facilitating the development of service programs that enable citizens, to address serious societal problems including, but not limited to the following areas: environment, health, education, education and public safety.
- III. The Private Industry Council shall be responsible for the following:
  - A Development of a national service plan for the State through an open and public process. The plan should cover a three year period and be updated annually.
  - B Oversee and submit the State's applications to the Corporation for National Service and other public and private funding sources.
  - C Fulfilling any other responsibilities required by the Corporation for National and Community Service and other funding sources, provided that such responsibilities are consistent with the purpose of this Executive Order.
  - D. Establishing procedures by which it shall operate.
