




REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant an annual salary increment to Frederick J. Lulka, Criminal Investigator (Position #9U376, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2611-014-500134) from a salary level of \$66,888.12 (LG BB, Step 4) to a salary level of \$70,536.44 (LG BB, Step 5); effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or February 16, 2018, whichever is the latter.

EXPLANATION

In accordance with NH RSA 94:1-a,I(a), Mr. Lulka is eligible for a salary increment, subject to the approval of the Governor and Executive Council. As a Criminal Investigator, Mr. Lulka has made invaluable contributions to this office. As such, he should be recognized with a salary increase to the next step of the salary schedule. Mr. Lulka's salary will increase by \$3,648.32.
