REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Continental Paving, Inc. (Vendor 155350) of Londonderry, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$2,426,591.20 for roadway and bridge rehabilitation on NH 16 in the town of Ossipee, from the date of Governor and Council approval through October 11, 2013 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$121,329.56 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

The 23820 project is part of the annual Federal Resurfacing Program (PRRCS) and the 16393 project is part of the Rail Crossing Program. The work involves pavement rehabilitation to approximately 5.5 miles of NH 16 consisting of 1 ½" – 2" inlay and 1 ½" overlay. The work also includes minor repairs to one bridge and partial and full-depth deck repairs at another. The work also encompasses reconstruction of a railroad crossing of NH 16 (Project #16393). The purpose of the pavement rehabilitation is to extend the pavement service life. Portions of NH 16 were last reconstructed in 1970 and 1997. The existing guardrail is in poor condition, and needs to be replaced to current standards. The purpose of the pavement rehabilitation project 23820 is to extend the pavement service life. The purpose of project 16393 is to improve the safety and serviceability of the existing rail crossing.

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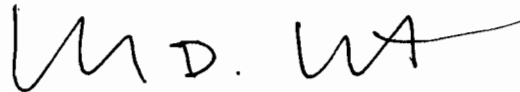
The contingency amount is proposed to be 5% of the contract amount. Adjusting limits to offset quantity overruns is not practical, and some of the work may need to be done at night to minimize traffic impacts.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

Construction funding for contract 23820 is 80% Federal Funding with Turnpike Toll Credits used as the State's 20% match. Contract 16393 has 100% Federal Funding for the Signal Force Account work and the remainder of the project has 90% Federal Funding with Turnpike Toll Credits used as the State's 10% match.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION: The Contract includes two projects on NH 16 in the Town of Ossipee. The projects were initiated and developed separately, but will be advertised as one Contract. The 23820 project consists of resurfacing of NH 16, from Mile 45.15 to Mile 50.7, including full width cold planing and inlay (2" deep) from Mile 45.15 to Mile 46.67, cold plane and inlay spot locations (1.5" deep) from Mile 46.67 to Mile 50.7, and overlay 1.5" full width from Mile 45.15 to Mile 50.7. Guardrail replacement, permanent sign replacement, under drain installation, minor repair of drainage structures, minor repairs to Bridge 238/112, and partial and/or full depth deck repairs to Bridge 232/121 are also included. The 16393 project includes reconstruction of the North Coast Railroad crossing and signals at NH 16, Mile 47.5, and realignment of the entrance to the railroad service yard adjacent to the tracks on the west side of NH 16.

FEDERAL FUNDING: Construction funding for contract 23820 is 80% Federal Funding with Turnpike Toll Credits used as the State's 20% match. Contract 16393 has 100% Federal Funding for the Signal Force Account work and the remainder of the project has 90% Federal Funding with Turnpike Toll Credits used as the State's 10% match.

CONTINGENCY: Further authorize that a contingency of 5% be approved which is reasonable considering the potential issues for this project, and is in accordance with Department guidelines. Adjusting limits to offset quantity overruns is not practical, and some of the work may need to be done at night to minimize traffic impacts.

PROJECT INITIATED: The projects were initiated through the State's 10-Year Transportation Improvement Program.

PROJECT EXPLANATION: The purpose of project 23820 is to extend the pavement service life. Portions of NH 16 were last reconstructed in 1970 and 1997. The NH 16 / NH 28 intersection was inlaid in 2008. The existing guardrail is in poor condition, and needs to be replaced to current standards. The purpose of project 16393 is to improve the safety and serviceability of the existing rail crossing.

TRAFFIC IMPLICATION: Shoulder closures will be required for guardrail, drainage, and work on Bridge 238/112. Deck repair on Bridge 232/121 will require a three phase operation using concrete barrier, with a duration of 4 – 6 weeks per phase. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained during bridge work. Lane and shoulder closures will be required for cold planing and paving. Because NH 16 is an NETC route, a 16' minimum lane width will be maintained during NETC hours. Based on daily and seasonal traffic volumes, the following lane closure restrictions are proposed from Memorial Day through Labor Day: Lane closures over 1 mile will not be allowed Monday - Thursday 8 am – 6 pm and Fridays 8 am – 9 pm. TCP will include speed reductions (during work operations only) from 55 mph to 45 mph and 50 mph to 40 mph using trailer mounted speed limit signs. The rail crossing replacement will require a temporary diversion of NH 16 to the west of the rail crossing, using alternating one way traffic during work hours. The duration of the crossing replacement work is expected to be 4 – 5 work days.

INTERMEDIATE COMPLETION DATE: June 14, 2013 for construction of the temporary diversion. The Agreement with the RxR will require the crossing replacement be complete by June 28, 2013.
