REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Pike Industries, Inc. (Vendor 177300) of Belmont, NH, on the basis of a low bid of \$6,981,484.59 for approximately 25 miles of pavement resurfacing and repair along NH 101 between Epping and Exeter, from the date of Governor and Council approval through July 30, 2021, unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in State Fiscal Year 2020 and Fiscal Year 2021 as follows, and is anticipated to be available in Fiscal Year 2022, upon the continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget, with the ability to adjust encumbrances through the Budget Office between State Fiscal Years if needed and justified:

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$349,074.23 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project is part of the State's Ten Year Transportation Improvement Plan under the Tier 1 Resurfacing Programs (Pave-T1-Resurf). This project on NH 101 begins at a pavement joint approximately ¼ mile east of Exit 5 (MM 115.2 EB, 115.1 WB) in Epping easterly to a pavement joint east of Exit 9 (MM 124.6) in Exeter for a total of 24.6 centerline miles.

Mainline work includes longitudinal joint micro-mill, crack fill, polymer modified Bonded Wearing Course (BWC) overlay of the travel way, and fog seal of the shoulders. Ramp work includes a full width 2" high strength wearing course inlay at the ramps at Exits 6, 7, 8, & 9.

The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the existing pavement infrastructure and minimize the need for costlier improvements in the near future. Work efforts include roadway resurfacing, upgrading guardrail, curb ramp reconstruction, and drainage structure adjustments.

The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. This project was not surveyed and therefore items have been quantified based on field observations, and aerial photos only. The sections will deteriorate over the 2019-2020 winter. Field adjustments may be required due to varying field conditions.

Although the bid costs exceeded the Department's estimate by 23.80% the low bid of 2 bids received is felt to be reasonable for the work involved. This project was previously bid on September 26, 2019, and was not awarded. Two bids were received, and both were approximately 22% above the Department's estimate. The project scope and construction timeline was modified for this bid in an effort to attract more competition. The same two contractors bid on the repackaged project with similar results (24% over the Department's estimate). Readvertising this project a third time would result, in our opinion, in higher prices and prevent the completion of the work in a timely manner. The Department considers it to be in the best interest of the State to accept this bid to accomplish these needed repairs.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is: 80% Federal (Pave-T1-Resurf), utilizing Turnpike Toll credits as the State's 20% match, effectively using 100% Federal Funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

Your approval of this resolution is respectfully requested.

SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION: This project on NH 101 begins at a pavement joint approximately ³/₄ mile east of Exit 5 (MM 115.2 EB, 115.1 WB) in Epping easterly to a pavement joint east of Exit 9 (MM 124.6) in Exeter for a total of 24.6 centerline miles.

Mainline work includes longitudinal joint micro-mill, crack fill, polymer modified Bonded Wearing Course (BWC) overlay of the travel way, and fog seal of the shoulders. Ramp work includes a full width 2" HS wearing course inlay at the ramps at Exits 6, 7, 8, & 9.

FEDERAL FUNDING: Pave-T1-Resurf (80%), Turnpike Toll Credit (20%).

CONTINGENCY: The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. The project was not surveyed and therefore, items have been quantified based on field observations, as-built plans, and aerial photos. Field adjustments may be required due to varying conditions. Asphalt prices are currently in escalation.

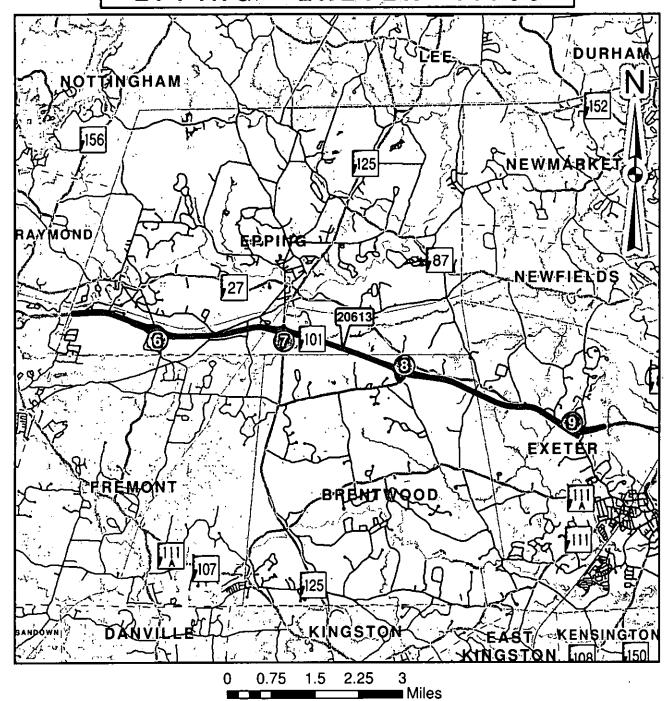
PROJECT INITIATED: 2020 Tier 1 Resurfacing Program.

PROJECT EXPLANATION: The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the existing pavement infrastructure and minimize the need for costlier improvements in the near future. Work efforts include roadway resurfacing, upgrading guardrail, curb ramp reconstruction, and drainage structure adjustments.

TRAFFIC IMPLICATION: All work requiring lane closure will be night work. One lane will be closed at a time on the mainline during construction activities. A 16-foot minimum lane width will be maintained at all times when travel is limited to one lane on NH 101. Ramp work will be night work. All Ramps at Exits 6 through 9 included in the project will be closed, one at a time, with detours in place to alternate exits along NH 101. The Work Zone was determined to be non-significant at the July 18, 2019 TCC Meeting.

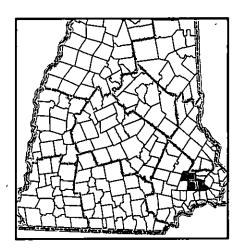
