## **REQUESTED ACTION**

Authorize the Department of Environmental Services to amend a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan agreement (P.O.# 9005460) with the Town of Ashland (VC #177354 B001) to increase funding by \$500,000, from \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000, under the provisions of RSA 486:14 and N.H. Code of Admin. Rules Env-Wq 500 et seq., effective upon Governor & Council approval. The original loan agreement was approved by Governor & Council on August 8, 2018 as Item No. 45. Funding is 100% **CWSRF Repayment Funds.**

## EXPLANATION

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the Town of Ashland's existing CWSRF loan by \$500,000 to fund value engineering, redesign and rebidding, as well as other construction phase engineering. services, due to initial bids over budget. This amendment also extends the original loan repayment term from 10 years to 20 years.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed, and may be less than \$2,000,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness in the amount of up to \$300,000.

Attached is a tabulation of the CWSRF showing the effect of this action on the funds available for loans.

#### ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT For Project CS-330064-06

To increase the Town of Ashland's loan amount for the Headworks and Septage Receiving Facility Project from \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000.

Now therefore, amend the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT, as approved by Governor and Council on August 8, 2018 as Item No. 45 in the following manner:

Change only Page 1 lines 16 through 17 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows:

"...State, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the principal sum of Two Million and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000,000) (Principal Sum) or such lesser amount as...";

And, change only Page 2, line 1 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows: "...Three Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$300,000). The principal forgiveness will...";

And, change only Page 3, line 6 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows: "...interest on the Note. The principal shall be paid in full within 20 years from the date of the ...";

And, change only Page 3, line 9 of the ORIGINAL LOAN AGREEMENT to read as follows: "...Completion date is hereby determined to be **December 2, 2019**; however, should the project...".

#### REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Environmental Services to approve a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan agreement with the Town of Ashland (VC #177354 B001) in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 to finance the Headworks and Septage Receiving Facility Project under the provisions of RSA 486:14 and N.H. Code of Admin. Rules Env-Wq 500 et seq., effective upon Governor & Council approval. Funding is 100% CWSRF Repayment Funds.

## EXPLANATION

The purpose of the requested action is to authorize the Town of Ashland to borrow up to \$1,500,000 from the CWSRF to finance the Headworks and Septage Receiving Facility Project. The project will include a new headworks building and upgrade of the headworks of the wastewater treatment facility. In addition, a septage receiving facility will be constructed to allow proper screening of waste transported to the facility by septage haulers. The upgraded facility will all improved treatment of wastewater and provide a facility for the disposal of septage from Ashland and nearby communities.

The Supplemental (final) loan amount will be based upon the total CWSRF funds disbursed, and may be less than \$1,500,000. Under federal capitalization grant requirements, this loan includes principal forgiveness of up to \$250,000. The interest rate for this Original Loan Agreement is 2.0000%.

Attached is a tabulation of the CWSRF showing the effect of this action on the funds available for loans.
