

BOARD OF AUCTIONEERS MINUTES  
State House Annex Room 405, Concord, NH

May 9, 2022 9:00 a.m.

1. The Board of Auctioneers convened at 9:13 a.m. with all members present; Robert S. Eaton III attending via telephone.
2. The Board on motion of Justin F. Conway, seconded by Gregory J. Peverly voted to authorize the minutes of the March 7, 2022 meeting.

*Board Member Robert S. Eaton III abstained from vote on item #'s 3 – 6 due to him not having access to the applications for review.*

3. The Board on motion of Frank Eaton, seconded by Justin F. Conway, authorized the application of Weston Robert Sager for an auctioneer's license.
4. The Board on motion of Frank Eaton, seconded by Justin F. Conway, authorized the application of Dennis Pietro for an auctioneer's license.
5. The Board on motion of Justin F. Conway, seconded by Frank Eaton, authorized the application of Brian Bazarnicki SR for an auctioneer's license.
6. The Board on motion of Frank Eaton, seconded by Justin F. Conway, authorized the application of Matthew Gagner for an auctioneer's license.
7. The Board was updated that Senate Bill 225, *relative to the bond required of applicants for auctioneer licenses* – passed both the NH House and the NH Senate as of May 4, 2022. The bill takes effect 60 days after passage. This bill repeals the bond required of applicants for an auctioneer license.
8. The Board on motion of Justin F. Conway, seconded by Frank Eaton voted to go into non-public session at 9:19 a.m. to discuss matters under RSA 91-A, specifically, matters which would likely adversely affect the privacy of individuals and or matters in which litigation has been threatened against the Board.
9. The Board on motion of Justin F. Conway, seconded by Frank Eaton and further on a roll call vote as follows: Frank Eaton - yes, Gregory J. Peverly – yes, Justin F. Conway – yes, and Robert S. Eaton III – yes, voted to seal the non-public session minutes.

10. Further Business

- A. The Board reviewed the application of Blakely Jenkins for an auctioneer's license. It was noted that the required bond submitted was in Mr. Jenkins business' name and not under him personally. Therefore, the Board on motion of Frank Eaton, seconded by Justin F. Conway, authorized the application contingent upon Mr. Jenkins submitting a corrected bond by May 20, 2022, with Robert S. Eaton III abstained from vote due to him not having access to the application for review.
- B. The Board was updated that the next Auctioneers exam was scheduled for May 16, 2022 and at present there were 2 registrations.
- C. Frank Eaton asked if the Board could get clarification for the next scheduled meeting from the Board's designated Legal Counsel on **311-B:13 Exceptions**. – VI. *Any auction conducted over the Internet shall be exempt from the requirements of this chapter*, as to what constitutes an on-line auction. *Example: If there is a live auction but items are purchased by an on-line bidder is it considered live or via internet, and would the Board have jurisdiction.*
