Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to reappoint Jill A. Perlow to Position #9U488 (Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-26200000-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary level of \$87,035.19, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or September 27, 2019, whichever is later. Ms. Perlow will be occupying a position for a five-year term ending September 28, 2024.

EXPLANATION


Ms. Perlow is a resident of Bow, New Hampshire and is a member of the New Hampshire Bar. She received her law degree, *magna cum laude*, from Vermont Law School in 2003 and her undergraduate degree in Political Science from the University of Miami in 1999. Ms. Perlow was an Attorney in the Civil Bureau with the Department of Justice from 2006 to 2008. From 2009 through 2013, she taught as an Adjunct Professor at New Hampshire Technical Institute, and was an Attorney at the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services from December 2011 through August 2013. Ms. Perlow then joined the New Hampshire Banking Department in August 2013, and was named Director of the Consumer Credit Division in 2014. In September 2015, she rejoined the Department of Justice in the Civil Bureau and was appointed an Assistant Attorney General. Ms. Perlow is currently assigned to the Civil Bureau and has been designated as a Senior Assistant Attorney General. A copy of her resume is attached. I plan to continue her current salary and assignment in the Civil Bureau.
