REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with All States Asphalt, Inc. of Sunderland, MA (Vendor 161291) on the basis of a single bid of \$2,276,375.00 for 16.9 miles of pavement preservation (Asphalt Rubber Chip Seal) at five separate locations in the State from the date of Governor and Council approval through August 14, 2015 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Betterment Funds.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$113,818.75 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project is part of the annual District Betterment Resurfacing Program. The work involves placing an asphalt rubber chip seal pavement preservation treatment along five segments of highway totaling 16.9 miles. The five segments involved are NH 118 (Dorchester); NH 112 (Albany); US 202 (Peterborough); US 4 (Boscawen, Canterbury and Concord); and NH 11 (Andover). The pavements on these segments are in fair to good condition and are good candidates for pavement preservation. No other work is expected. The intent of this project is to extend the pavement life.

The contingency amount is proposed to be 5% of the contract amount. This is a one-season duration contract, with fixed limits, being constructed during a time of unstable fuel prices. Adjusting limits to offset quantity overruns is not practical and potential fuel and asphalt adjustments need to be considered. Construction under high traffic volumes, maintaining two-lane traffic during certain hours and lane closures operations also increase the risk of overruns for traffic control operations.

Although there was only one bid received and the bid costs exceeded the Department's estimate, this bid is felt to be reasonable for the work involved. Re-advertising this project would result, in our opinion, in higher prices and prevent the completion of the work in a timely manner. The Department considers it to be in the best interest of the State to accept this bid.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION: This project involves 16.9 miles of pavement preservation (AR Chip Seal) at five separate locations. The first section is on NH 118 (Dorchester), from 2,000 feet north of the Canaan/Dorchester Town line northerly the intersection of North Dorchester Road. The second section is on NH 112 (Albany), from a pavement joint 500 feet west of Oliverian Brook Road easterly to the intersection of Passaconway Road. The third section is on US 202 (Peterborough), from a pavement joint 300 feet north of the intersection of Vose Farm Road northerly to a pavement joint approximately 400 feet south of the Hancock/Peterborough Town line. The fourth section is on US 4 (Boscawen/Canterbury/Concord), from approximately 500 feet east of the eastern intersection of US 3 in Boscawen easterly to the intersection of Boyce Road in Concord. The fifth section is on NH 11 (Andover), from a joint approximately 500 feet west of the intersection of Plains Road easterly to a pavement joint approximately 350 feet west of the intersection of Hoyt Road

FEDERAL FUNDS: 0% (100% Betterment).

CONTINGENCY: The contingency amount is proposed to be 5% for this contract. This is a one-season duration contract, with fixed limits, being constructed during a time of unstable fuel prices. Adjusting limits to offset quantity overruns is not practical and potential fuel and asphalt adjustments need to be considered. Construction under high traffic volumes, maintaining two-lane traffic during certain hours and lane closure operations also increase the risk of overruns for traffic control operations.


PROJECT INITIATED: State's 10-Year Transportation Improvement Program under the "parent" project BRES # 581 (District Betterment Resurfacing Program).

PROJECT EXPLANATION: NH 118 (Dorchester) was rehabilitated (Reclaimed & 4" H.B.P.) in 2009. NH 112 (Albany) was rehabilitated (Reclaimed & 3½" H.B.P.) in 2005. NH 152 (Lee-Nottingham) has a recent paving history of placing a ⅜-inch paver shim in 1999, 2004 and a ¾-inch paver shim in 2010. The pavement is in good condition and is a good candidate for pavement preservation. No other work is expected. The intent of this project is to extend the pavement life.

TRAFFIC IMPLICATIONS: Alternating one-way traffic will be allowed only on roads with pavement widths less than forty-eight feet. Normal traffic patterns will be re-established prior to the beginning of non-work hours. No work will be permitted from May 22 to May 26 and July 2 to July 6, 2015. No work on Section 3-PP01, NH 112 (Albany) shall take place June 12 to June 22, 2015 (Motorcycle week).
