BUREAU OF SECURITIES REGULATION'S MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF FEES AND COSTS

NOW COMES Petitioner, the New Hampshire Bureau of Securities Regulation (the "Bureau" or the "Petitioner"), through counsel Bernstein, Shur, Sawyer & Nelson, P.A., and submits this motion for approval of its fees and costs in the amount of \$571,398.86, fully aware of the Final Order's preference for mediation, but concerned that the Hearing Officer may be divested of jurisdiction upon issuance of a ruling on requests for rehearing and a quick filing of a Notice of Appeal that would transfer jurisdiction to the New Hampshire Supreme Court. The Petitioner fully intends to comply with the Order's requirements of negotiation and mediation, but wishes this motion to be filed in a timely fashion. In support thereof Petitioner states as follows:

- 1. By Final Order dated August 16, 2012, the Presiding Officer ruled in favor of the Bureau with respect to Counts 1 and 2 of the Petition (the "5-B Counts"), and ruled in favor of the Respondents with respect to Counts 3, 4, & 5 of the Petition (the "Securities Counts").
- 2. Pursuant to the Final Order, the Respondents were found "jointly and severally liable for the costs of the investigation in this matter, and all related proceedings, including reasonable attorney fees, pursuant to RSA 5-B:4-a, V and are ordered to pay same." Final Order at 80.
 - 3. Counsel for the Bureau has submitted to counsel for the Respondents the attached

accounting of the Bureau's costs of investigation and reasonable attorneys fees, excluding fees associated with work on the Securities Counts, and excluding the Bureau's personnel costs for Bureau attorneys who worked extensively on this matter for almost a year. *See* Exhibit 1 attached hereto. The Bureau also submits Mr. Volinsky's affidavit as Exhibit 2 hereto.

- 4. The Bureau's costs of investigation and reasonable attorneys fees, adjusted accordingly, are equal to \$571,398.86.
- 5. Counsel for the Bureau has conferred with counsel for Respondents to determine an agreed upon amount of costs to be paid by Respondents, as required by the Final Order, but no such agreement was reached.
- 6. Accordingly, the Bureau hereby submits its itemization of costs and fees to the Presiding Officer for his review and approval, and respectfully requests that the Presiding Officer issue an Order requiring the Respondents to pay to the Bureau \$571,398.86.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Securities Regulation respectfully requests that the Presiding Officer approve the Bureau's itemization of costs and Orders these costs and fees to be paid by Respondents within a reasonable time set by the Presiding Officer.

Now comes the affiant, Andru H. Volinsky, and hereby swears or affirms as follows.

- 1. I am a shareholder in the firm of Bernstein, Shur, Sawyer and Nelson, P.A. I am also a member of the law firm's Office of General Counsel. In these capacities, I am familiar with the firm's procedures for time keeping in billing matters.
