Attached hereto is a Petition for a hearing on alterations to US 1 in the Town of Seabrook.

Since the Petition is not for the limitation or control of access, a Commission should be appointed to hold a hearing, and, if the necessity is found, to layout the new highway at this location.

This project is in 10 Year Plan as an element of the Highway Safety Improvement Program. The purpose of the project is to widen US 1 to add a second southbound travel lane to improve safety. This work will require the acquisition of some right-of-way. No building acquisitions are required.

To Her Excellency, the Governor, and the Honorable Executive Council:

In accordance with RSA 230:14, I, Christopher D. Clement, Sr., Commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, propose to widen a segment of US 1 to add a second southbound travel lane in the Town of Seabrook, at the locations given below:

Seabrook, X-A002(762), 16444

This project will widen a segment of US 1 to add a second southbound travel lane to improve safety and traffic operations at the signalized intersection of US 1, Railroad Avenue and Pine Street. The proposed widening of US 1 will begin approximately 400' south of the US 1/NH 107 intersection (in the vicinity of Perkins Avenue) and extend south approximately 2,000' to the vicinity of Autumn Way). The project will also extend Autumn Way to intersect Pine Street, thus providing safer access to US 1 via the existing Pine Street traffic signal. This project may impact historic properties.

Therefore, in accordance with RSA 230:14, I, Christopher D. Clement, Sr., Commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, propose the improvements to US 1 and Autumn Way in the Town of Seabrook, New Hampshire.
