- (2) releases and forever discharges the said Personal Representatives and the Decedent's estate from all claims and demands of and all accountability and responsibility to the Beneficiary in regard to the Property;
- (3) waives the right to any and all accountings provided by the Will or otherwise provided by law;
- (4) acknowledges that no formal inventory or valuation of the Property has been performed;
- (5) represents and warrants that the Beneficiary has not assigned, transferred or encumbered in any way, voluntarily or involuntarily, either in whole or in part, the Beneficiary's right, title and interest in and to the Property; and
- (6) agrees that the provisions of this document shall inure to the benefit of the Personal Representatives, both individually and in their capacity as fiduciaries, and to the benefit of their heirs, legal representatives and any successor or successors, and shall be binding on the Beneficiary and its heirs, legal representatives and assigns.
