

BOARD OF AUCTIONEERS MINUTES
Legislative Office Building Room 307, Concord, NH
March 4, 2013, 9:00 a.m.

1. The Board of Auctioneers convened at 9:00 a.m. with, Chairperson Russell R. Abbott, Vice-Chairman Roy W. Tilsley, Secretary Gregory J. Walsh, Member Richard C. Berman, and Member Frank L. Eaton present.
2. The Board on motion of Roy W. Tilsley, seconded by, Richard C. Berman accepted the minutes of the February 4, 2013 meeting.
3. The Board on motion of Richard C. Berman, seconded by Gregory J. Walsh, authorized the application of Jason M. Benware for an Auctioneers License.
4. The Board on motion of Roy W. Tilsley, seconded by Richard C. Berman, voted to defer the application of David Comley for an Auctioneers License to the next meeting of the Board, scheduled for April 1, 2013. The apprenticeship affidavit requires a list of no less than 10 auction dates and locations to which the apprentice worked, as well as what part he/she took during those auctions. Mr. Comley's form was incomplete. Due to this deferment, the applicant will now be required to extend his bond date through April 1, 2015.
5. The Board on motion of Frank L. Eaton, seconded by Richard C. Berman, authorized the application of Kathy Jean Lavoie for an Auctioneers License.
6. The Board on motion of Frank L. Eaton, seconded by Roy W. Tilsley, voted to defer the application of Stephan J. Miranti for an Auctioneers License to the next meeting of the Board, scheduled for April 1, 2013. It is a requirement that all recommendations be from someone the applicant has done past business dealings with. Mr. Miranti needs to provide such recommendations. Due to this deferment, the applicant will now be required to extend his bond date through April 1, 2015.
7. The Board on motion of Roy W. Tilsley, seconded by Gregory J. Walsh, authorized the application of John B. O'Keefe for an Auctioneers License.
8. The Board on motion of Frank L. Eaton, seconded by Roy W. Tilsley, authorized the application of Dennis E. Prescott for an Auctioneers License.
9. The Board on motion of Roy W. Tilsley, seconded by Frank L. Eaton, authorized the application of Joshua C. Reynolds for an Auctioneers License.
10. The Board discussed Rules.
