EXPLANATION

Agency Income from the Management and Protection Fund is derived from various sources, the majority of which is from the sale of timber on state lands.

We are requesting use of funds to build a forest access road for a timber sale at Second Presidential State Forest in Lincoln, NH. The budget was appropriated for this project in FY17 but was not encumbered prior to fiscal year end due to difficulties acquiring the appropriate paperwork from the vendor during the equipment rental process.

The following appropriation is requested for Fiscal Year 2018:

Class 022 - Rents-Leases Other than State \$14,500, for equipment rental to build forest access road

We are also requesting use of funds for data collection and research at Nash Stream State Forest. This is in response from input from the public and other stakeholders during the current management plan revision comment period which occurred after the current budget was submitted. Nash Stream Forest is the largest State Reservation and we have limited staff in the North Country. We will use summer technicians to gather forest inventory data and contract with a research forester to establish research plots that will be used to track growth rates in managed and unmanaged portions of the forest.

The following appropriations are requested for Fiscal Year 2018:

Class 048 - Contractual Maintenance B&G \$5,000, for research forester to establish research plots;

Class 050 - Personal Service Temp \$13,500, for technicians to gather forest inventory data; and

Class 060 - Benefits \$1,500, related to part-time technicians.
