REQUESTED ACTION

1. Pursuant to the provisions of RSA 14:30-a, VI, Additional Revenues, authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Services, Bureau of Population Health and Community Services to accept and expend federal funds in the amount of \$104,650 from the Health Resources and Services Administration to fund the full-time Public Health Nurse Coordinator position effective August 1, 2018 upon approval by the Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council, through June 30, 2019, and further authorize the funds to be allocated as follows. Grant funds awarded for periods after SFY 2019 will be included in the operating budgets for SFY 2020 and SFY 2021. 100% Federal Funds.

2. Contingent upon the approval of Requested Action 1 above and pursuant to RSA 124:15, authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Services, Bureau of Population Health and Community Services, Maternal and Child Health Section to continue one currently filled full-time temporary (class 059) position, utilizing funds from the Health Resources and Services Administration, by extending the end date from August 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 effective upon approval by Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council. 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

The Maternal and Child Health Section seeks to accept and expend Federal funds to support a Public Health Nurse Coordinator to coordinate the Birth Conditions Program and ensure follow-up services for the Early Hearing Detection and Intervention Program. In 2017, a skilled Public Health Nurse Coordinator was hired to oversee a Zika Surveillance, Intervention and Referral Program funded by the Zika Pregnancy Surveillance grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The aim of this funding was to monitor and provide services for infants born with Zika-related birth conditions such as microcephaly. The Department was notified that the grant period has been reduced and will now end July 31, 2018. The Maternal and Child Health Section requests to maintain the Public Health Nurse Coordinator position with Federal funds from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Title V - Maternal and Child Health Block Grant and Universal Newborn Hearing Screening Grant. This position has successfully re-established New Hampshire's Birth Conditions Program that provides surveillance and support for all birth defects, including any conditions as a result of Zika virus, and has the unique skills to provide follow up services for infants born with hearing loss. HRSA encourages the use of Title V - Maternal and Child Health Block Grant and Universal Newborn Hearing Screening funds for these activities. While this request seeks permission to change the source of funds from CDC funding to HRSA funding, no new programs will be established. These activities are authorized by RSA 132:10-a and Administrative Rules He-P 3012 and He-P 3008. The Supplemental Job Description for the Public Health Nurse Coordinator is being changed concurrently to reflect the modified job responsibilities as of August 1, 2018.

Funds are budgeted as follows:

Class 037 - PC Desktop hardware – New for the anticipated purchase of new or replacement computer hardware.

Class 038 - Desktop Software for the anticipated purchase of software for the PC purchased above.

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Class 041 - Audit Fund Set Aside per state requirements.

Class 059 and Class 060 Full Time Temporary Personnel and Benefits, if approved in item 1, to support a Public Health Nurse Coordinator for oversight and continue implementation of the program.

The following information is provided in accordance with the Comptroller's instructional memorandum dated September 21, 1981:

- List of personnel involved: Full-Time Public Health Nurse Coordinator, LG 23, Position #9T2887.
- 2) Nature, need and duration: The Public Health Nurse Coordinator will have the responsibility for the administrative and programmatic operations of the Birth Conditions Program per He-P 3012 and follow-up coordination for the Newborn Hearing Screening Program as per He-P 3008.
- Relationship to existing agency programs:

The activities will be coordinated with the current Maternal and Child Health Section responsibilities, the Division of Public Health Services and the Department of Health and Human Services as a whole.

4) Has similar program been requested of the Legislature and denied?

No .

5) Why wasn't funding included in the agency's budget request?

It was unknown at the time of the initial award that the funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention would end earlier than anticipated. Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) Title V funds may be used to maintain these services.

6) Can portions of the grant funds be utilized for other purposes?

Federal funds allocated to the state cannot be used for other purposes.

7) Estimate the funds required to continue this position:

Position (Salary & Benefits) FY 2019
Public Health Nurse Coordinator \$97,694

In response to the anticipated two-part question; "Can these funds be used to offset General Funds?" and "What is the compelling reason for not offsetting General Funds?" the Division offers the following information: These funds may not be used to offset General Funds as they are specifically granted to the State for the purpose of providing the services described above.

These funds will not change the program eligibility levels. No new program will be established with the acceptance of these funds.

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Area served: Statewide

Source of funds: These funds are 100% Federal from the US Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) to fund the Public Health Nurse Coordinator position. Attached are the Notice of Grant Award and Award History.

In the event that these Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.
