Authorize the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, to accept and expend a grant entitled, "Disaster FEMA 4316-DR-NH" in the amount of \$14,534.00 from the State of New Hampshire, Department of Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, for cost incurred during the declared event of the March 2017 Severe Winter Storm. Effective upon Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2020. Funding source: 100% Agency Income.

#### **Explanation**

The NH Department of Safety incurred personnel labor costs at the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (HSEM) during the event of the March 2017 Severe Winter Storm in order to open and operate the Emergency Operation Center (EOC), as well as for additional State Police patrols to block roads that were not passable and provide additional security to protect residents and prevent damage to public and private property. During the incident period, New Hampshire experienced excessive heavy snow and high winds, which resulted in extensive damage throughout Belknap and Carroll counties. The award amount of \$14,534.00 represents the 75% federal share of the total approved eligible costs incurred by the State in 2017. Funds will be used to offset SFY2020 expenses.

The funds in Class 018, Overtime, were used for labor costs incurred to open and operate the EOC and responding around Belknap and Carroll Counties to protect public safety during and after the event.

The funds in Class 020, Current Expenses, were used for labor costs incurred in order to open and operate the Emergency Operation Center including food for employees working in the EOC.

The funds in Class 039, Telecommunications, were used for costs incurred in order to open and operate the EOC including conference calls.

The funds in Class 060, Benefits, were used for the benefit costs associated with the above labor expenses.
