Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety (DOS) to accept the donation of three (3) weather-tight, cargo containers (Conex boxes), valued at \$4,500.00, from the Defense Logistics Agency to be used for long-term storage by the Division of State Police at 41 Hazen Drive, Concord. Effective upon Governor and Council approval.
