EXPLANATION

The New Hampshire Fish and Game Department, Law Enforcement Division has approved funding through the Department of Safety and the Governor and Executive Council in the amount of \$33,090.00 for the purchase of Homeland Security First Responder reimbursements of costs associated with overtime and mileage. The application and grant award was under the 2013 State Homeland Security Grant Program. The purpose of the grant is to enable Conservation Officers in conjunction with state, local and county police to be reimbursed for patrol time along the northern border. While conducting law enforcement patrols near the northern border, Conservation Officers at times interact with individuals gaining entry into this country illegally. To enhance more patrols along the border as it relates to the illegal taking of wildlife and illegal entry into the United States, this grant will allow for some reimbursement of costs through specific details organized with our partners. The sub-grant was awarded through the Department of Safety in a request to the Governor and Executive Council at the January 29, 2014 meeting, item # 49. This is the second installment of the sub-grant, the first installment was approved by Governor and Council March 26, 2014 # 42.

In addition, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), National Marine Fisheries Service has approved funding for reimbursement of costs associated with special overtime details. These special details are to locate violations of the Magnuson-Stevenson Act, Lacy Act and International Unreported and Unidentified fisheries being transported between States and International borders. Specifically, fisheries being targeted would be Northeast Multispecies to include groundfish and lobster and Highly Migratory species such as tuna. Conservation Officers in conjunction with New Hampshire State Police Motor Vehicle Troopers and National Marine Fisheries Service Agents would conduct operations along state highways checking commercial vehicles carrying seafood products while in transit for fisheries violations. The total approved funding for these costs is \$12,513. The requested transfer amount of \$11,101 represents actual costs minus indirect costs.

Homeland State Agency Grants \$33,090.20

Explanation

This State Agency award is funded as part of the 2013 Department of Homeland Security Grant Program under a special limited purpose allocation known as "Operation Stonegarden" (OPSG). OPSG funds are intended to enhance cooperation and coordination among local, Tribal, territorial, State, and Federal law enforcement agencies in a joint mission to secure the United States' borders along routes of ingress from international borders to include travel corridors in States bordering Mexico and Canada, as well as States and territories with international water borders. The Department of Fish and Game is a partner in this program in Coos County. In addition to limited eligible equipment, targeted overtime patrols will be conducted by law enforcement officials in the region.

This grant award to the Department of Fish and Game is for: . .

- \$9,800.00 for the purchase of one snowmachine to focus on interdiction of snowmobiles and/or OHRV's crossing the international border from Canada,
- \$19,294.20 to cover overtime and associated benefits for Operation Stonegarden details conducted,

\$3,996.00 to cover mileage for Operation Stonegarden details conducted.

Highway Funds or General Funds will not be used should Federal Funds become unavailable.
