## SCHEDULING ORDER REGARDING DOCUMENT EXCHANGE AND NOTICE OF HEARING

Following discussion with counsel representing all parties regarding the completion of the exchange of all documents among the parties in advancement of a final hearing on the merits of the several allegations against the respondents contained in the petition of the Bureau of Securities Regulation, the presiding officer issues the following:

- No later than Monday, November 14, 2011 the Bureau of Securities Regulation (BSR) shall provide to respondents LGC and its affiliates and Maura Carroll, in digital form, all additional material in its possession or subject to its custody not being withheld pending a future decision on the parties' respective motions to produce documents or to compel production of previously requested materials to all respondents.
- 2. No later than Monday, November 14, 2011 the BSR shall provide to the other named individual respondents all material that it previously provided to respondents LGC and its affiliates and Maura Carroll and the same additional material referenced in the above statement #1.

- 3. No later than Tuesday, November 15, 2011 the BSR shall provide to the respondents a so-called "Vaughn Index" or similar specific index describing the documents requested by LGC and its affiliates and Maura Carroll that it is withholding and legal basis for said withholding pending a future decision on the parties' respective motions to produce documents or to compel production of previously requested materials to all respondents.
- 4. Counsel for all parties shall meet and confer on Wednesday, November 16, 2011 or such other time mutually agreed to, prior to Monday, November 21, 2011, for the purpose of streamlining issues, cooperating in the exchange of requested materials, discussing methods for allowing forensic accounting analysis that serves the economies of justice, discussing previously withheld documents and reasonable privacy limitations, potential settlement of any issues, and any other topics that may contribute to the timely and orderly conduct of these proceedings.
- 5. A hearing shall be conducted on Monday, November 21, 2011 beginning at 9:00 AM for the purpose of allowing oral argument on motions to produce or motions to compel production of previously requested documents pending at that time. All supporting legal memoranda anticipated by counsel shall be submitted at that hearing as the issues should be well framed, given the parties' previous discussions, index submissions and filings.
