REQUESTED ACTION

- 1. Pursuant to RSA 215-A:23, IX and RSA 215-C:39, X, authorize the transfer of \$500,000.00 of unexpended funds from Excess Registration Fees, Account Number 20-07500-11830000-009-405928 to the Fish and Game OHRV Fiscal Year 2017 Operating Budget.
- 2. Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department (NHFGD) to accept and expend twenty four thousand six hundred and forty nine dollars (\$24,649) in agency income from the Department of Safety Office of Highway Safety for the purpose of conducting Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) patrols and five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in private funds from the City of Berlin for reimbursement of Department Conservation Officer's overtime from date of Joint Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2017. 100% Other Funds/Agency Income.

EXPLANATION

Pursuant to RSA 215-A:23 IX, and RSA 215-C:39, X, "Any excess registration fees collected and not expended shall be non-lapsing and shall be retained by the snowmobile and OHRV program for future use." In each year of the biennium, the Fish and Game Department and the Department of Resources and Economic Development may expend the excess fees collected in the same proportion as described in this section with prior approval of the Fiscal Committee and the Governor and Council.

The Department's FY 2017, class 049, Transfers to Other Agencies, is insufficient for this fiscal year due to this past winter being a very good snow year which resulted in above average sales of snowmobile registrations. We currently have insufficient funds to transfer the required funds to the Department of Economic Development for their share of registrations. This transfer into class 049 will allow us to transfer required funds through the remainder of the fiscal year.

In an effort to combat the DWI problem, the Department applied for and received a grant from the Department of Safety, Office of Highway Safety to conduct DWI patrols on those evenings (Friday, Saturday, and holidays) and during those times (12:00 Noon-12:00am) when drunk driving is felt to be most prevalent. The Department has up until this time, overlooked the need to bring this request forward for Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval. These grant funds were not known about during the current biennial budget process, therefore were not considered as part of the class 018, overtime, expenditures.

The City of Berlin agreed to pay the Department \$5,000 to conduct special event details at their Polaris Camp RZR event held in September, this request budgets these funds appropriately in class 018, overtime.
