

We the undersigned challenge the eligibility of Ms. Diane Kelley of Hadley Highway, Temple, New Hampshire to stand for election specifically during this November 3rd General Election for the position of Hillsborough House District 25 Representative. We are concerned that she does not meet the two-year residency requirement as defined in RSA 654:1 of the laws of the New Hampshire General Court and as demonstrated by required documentation listed in RSA 654:2.


Of concern is the moment of Ms. Kelley's establishment of actual legal domicile within District 25, as opposed to the moment at which Ms. Kelley formally took ownership of a piece of property.

We believe that she established domicile after November 3, 2018.


