Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increase to Thomas R. Worboys, as an Assistant Attorney General (Position #9U217, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2615-013-500132), from a salary level of \$78,110 to a salary level of \$85,000 **retroactive** to July 1, 2019 upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

EXPLANATION

In accordance with the 2001 N.H. Laws Chapter 158, Section 101, and 2018 N.H. Laws Chapter 162, Section 14, this request seeks your approval to grant a salary increase for Assistant Attorney General Thomas R. Worboys. This item is **retroactive** because funds in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 biennium budget were not available to submit this request prior to July 1, 2019.

Mr. Worboys is a resident of Manchester. He received his law degree from Northeastern University School of Law in 2003. Prior to joining the Department of Justice, Mr. Worboys worked in Massachusetts at the Flynn Law Firm from 2003 through 2008 and at Morrison Mahoney, LLP from 2008 through 2013. Between 2013 and 2018 he worked at Colucci, Colucci, Marcus & Flavon, P.C., Milton, Massachusetts. In May 2018, he joined the Department as an attorney in the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and was appointed an Assistant Attorney General on May 10, 2019. Mr. Worboys' salary will increase by \$6,890, from \$78,110 to \$85,000. I will continue his assignment in the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit.


