Senate elects Senate President, Clerk, Assistant Clerk and Sergeant-at-Arms*

- *State Representatives-elect are sworn into office by the Governor and Executive Councilors
Representatives elect Speaker of the House and other officers*

- *Senate and House of Representatives in Joint Session [Art. 67, Pt. II, N.H. Constitution]
Elect Secretary of State
Elect State Treasurer*

December 19, 2016

January 4, 2017

January 5, 2017
