Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to accept the donation of twenty eight (28) David Clark headsets with a value of approximately \$19,311.88 from Banneker Industries to be used by the Division of State Police Special Enforcement Unit. Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

The Department of Safety, Division of State Police, has been given the opportunity to acquire through donation twenty-eight (28) used David Clark headsets from Banneker Industries with an approximate value of \$19,311.88, based on the purchase price of new headsets. Banneker Industries routinely donates its used surplus equipment and, in this case, the donation is due to the discontinuation of the headsets. The donated headsets will provide the occupants of the Division's aircraft with better hearing protection and more options. The Special Enforcement Unit will benefit from these headsets as they are of significantly better quality than those currently being used. The currently used headsets are aging and are not capable of "noise cancelling", which decreases the harm to an occupant's hearing. Furthermore, this donation will not only provide for enough headsets for all occupants in the aircrafts, but will also provide for replacement parts as needed.
