#### **Explanation**

This grant will assist the NH State Police Sex Offender Registry (SOR) with identifying and tracking the sex offender population living, working or attending school in New Hampshire by supplementing the State Police forces currently available to address registry at the local level statewide in partnership with local enforcement, the US Attorney's Office and the U.S. Marshals. This grant will enable NH State Police to provide a more efficient and aggressive SOR to the state, which in turn will ensure sex offender accountability and compliance, as well as continuing our efforts for NH to become compliant with the required minimum sex offender registration and notification standards set forth in the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA).

The request to reallocate funds is needed as follows:

Class 018 Increased to cover the overtime details to assist with the tracking and monitoring of sex offenders.

Class 040 Increased to cover the increase in the indirect cost rate compared to SFY 2015. Her Excellency, Governor Margaret Wood Hassan and the Honorable Council April 19, 2016 Page 2 of 2

Class 050 Decreased due to the Auxiliary Troopers not working as many hours as first predicted when grant was

awarded.

Class 060 Increased to cover the benefits related to the increase in class 018.

In the event that Agency Income is no longer available, General Funds and/or Highway Funds will not be requested to support this program.

Funds in class 050 are needed to pay part time salaries. This funding is not required to create new positions; it is needed to pay existing Auxiliary Trooper positions within in the Department of Safety to assist in the NH State Police SOR as approved by the awarding agency.

Funds in class 060 are needed to pay for benefits related to the class 018 and class 050.

In the event that Agency Income is no longer available, General Funds and/or Highway Funds will not be requested to support this program.
