EXPLANATION

The Department is requesting to budget and expend funds that municipalities and other State DOT's paid for their portion of a project, due to higher-than-expected work on municipal and other State DOT projects. The Department can be the lead on projects for other State DOT's and construction on municipal projects. Revenues received were higher than anticipated during the budget process. It is requested that the funds replenish the appropriations related to construction materials.

Class 400 Increase Construction – Repairs & Materials by \$8,991,519 to replenish appropriations used on municipal and other State DOT projects.
