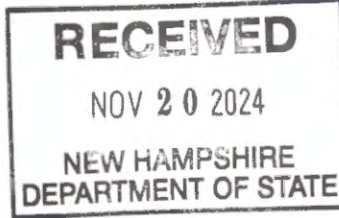

Dear Commissioner Chattopadhyay,

EPRI cordially invites you to participate in the EPRI Specialized Lab Site visit in Lenox, MA on October 21-22, 2024. The visit will include a dinner on October 21 followed by a tour of the EPRI Lab on October 22. Given that Lenox is not close to an airport, EPRI has contracted rooms at the Goodwin Hotel in Hartford, Connecticut for four participants. The tour will depart at 9 a.m. from the Goodwin Hotel in Hartford and will return to the hotel at approximately 3:30 p.m.

Note that the lab is approximately a 90 minute drive from the hotel. If you plan on flying home on October 22, please allow for sufficient time to get from the hotel to the airport. We suggest not booking flight prior to 5:30 p.m. For those staying on October 22, EPRI will host a casual dinner that evening.

The EPRI Specialized Lab Site visit will provide state commissioners with a unique opportunity to observe EPRI lab capabilities that highlight innovative technology in the energy sector and to better understand the research, development, and demonstration capabilities that EPRI has. State commissioners will have direct access to EPRI subject matter experts, who will be available to explain and discuss current advancements in technology at the Lenox lab. Participation in this one-of-a-kind event is by invitation only to state commissioners throughout the United States. The dinner and lab visit are designed to provide utility commissioners a better understanding of the collaborative projects and customized research that EPRI conducts.
