#### REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Resources and Economic Development (DRED) and the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to exchange management responsibility for State land parcels of approximately equal acreage located in Concord, New Hampshire, said parcels consisting of approximately 0.89 acres of Russell Shea State Forest land to be annexed to the abutting DHHS Russell Farm parcel at 84 Iron Works Road in exchange for approximately 1.03 acres of the DHHS Russell Farm parcel to be annexed to the abutting Russell Shea State Forest. **No Funding Required** 

#### **EXPLANATION**

DHHS is in the process of preparing for disposal pursuant to RSA 4:40 the land and buildings comprising the DHHS Russell Farm property at 84 Iron Works Road, Concord, New Hampshire ("Russell Farm"). Because Russell Farm is presently part of a larger tax parcel that also includes part of Russell Shea State Forest, the tax parcel must be subdivided with the approval of the City of Concord Planning Board before DHHS may sell the resulting Russell Farm parcel to a third party. At the request of the Rivers Management Advisory Committee (RMAC) and the interagency Council on Resources and Development (CORD), and with the advice of RMAC member agencies including the Department of Environmental Services, Fish and Game Department, and DRED, DHHS has agreed with DRED to make the interagency land exchange described herein for the purpose of preserving in its natural and undeveloped state a portion of the Russell Farm parcel consisting of a strip of land along the west bank of the Turkey River without causing DHHS to suffer a significant reduction in the net acreage and marketability of the Russell Farm parcel to be sold. An additional purpose is to assure State owned connectivity between abutting State Forest lands in the Turkey River basin in the vicinity of Iron Works Road.

The proposed exchange is already incorporated into the tax parcel subdivision application, which received conditional approval from the City Planning Board on February 19, 2014. The completion of the proposed exchange is one of the conditions remaining to be satisfied prior to obtaining final Planning Board approval of the subdivision. The proposed exchange is summarized by the two attached declarations of Transfer of Management Responsibility, both of

which remain subject to final approval by the Department of Justice as to form, substance and execution.



A certain parcel of land located near Iron Works Road, consisting of approximately 0.89 acres, more or less, and shown as "Portion of NH-DRED Management Area to be Transferred to NH-DHHS" on a plan

entitled "Management Boundary Plat prepared for the State of New Hampshire DRED and DHHS, Project Location: Map 93, Block 1, Lot 2, 84 Iron Works Rd, Concord NH" dated January 2013, prepared by Richard D. Bartlett & Associates, LLC, on file with DRED and DHHS (the "Plan"), more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a steel pin found at the northeast corner of land now or formerly of Daniel F. and Kristin W. Dunklee, located North 23°42'35" West a distance of approximately 345.92 feet from a point along the northerly side of Iron Works Road at the southeast corner of said land of Dunklee;

Thence North 84°14'05" East along other land now or formerly of the State of New Hampshire a distance of approximately 234.46 feet to a steel pin set at the easterly corner of the herein described parcel;

Thence North 54°43'55" West along other land now or formerly of the State of New Hampshire a distance of approximately 273.71 feet to a steel pin set at the northerly corner of the herein described parcel;

Thence South 35°16'05" West along other land now or formerly of the State of New Hampshire a distance of approximately 250.51 feet to a steel pin set in the northeasterly line of land now or formerly of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc., being the westerly corner of the herein described parcel;

Thence South 56°24'05" East along said land now or formerly of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. a distance of approximately 99.71 feet to a rebar found, being the southerly corner of the herein described parcel;

Thence North 33°32'50" East along the aforementioned land of Dunklee a distance of approximately 93.72 feet to the point of beginning.

The management responsibility transferred to DHHS hereby shall include full responsibility for the Premises. The transfer memorialized hereby shall have the effect of removing the herein described parcel from Russell Shea State Forest.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Transfer of Land Management Responsibility is to provide to DHHS a parcel of land to be annexed to the abutting Russell Farm parcel in exchange for a parcel of land of approximately equal area along the Turkey River to be transferred concurrently herewith from DHHS to DRED to be annexed to the abutting Russell Shea State Forest.
