EXPLANATION

This request is **Sole Source** because University System of New Hampshire has one of the premier facilities in New Hampshire, and can provide the perfect venue for the summer learning conference. The New Hampshire Department of Education (NHED) receives an annual grant under the Strengthening Career and Technical Education of the 21st Century Act. Section 124(1)(C) of that Act charges the State with the responsibility of providing professional development opportunities for career and technical education administration and staff. The NHED will host a one-day professional development conference for Career and Technical Education (CTE) professionals and stakeholders. This event was approved by the Governor and Executive Council on April 6th, 2022 item #64. The University System will provide a forum for NH Career and Technical Education (CTE) professionals to participate in a collaborative professional development experience, hosted on the campus of the University of New Hampshire.
