



EXPLANATION

This request is being made to accept the additional grant funds available for SFY 2020 to administer the Family Domestic Grant in compliance with conditions set forth in the applicable Program Instructions, terms and conditions, Department regulations, and OMB Circulars under the Family Violence Prevention and Services act (42 USC 10401). The grant award is higher than anticipated.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Class 102 – Contract funds will be used for the provision of statewide domestic violence prevention services as required by RSA 631:2-b. These funds provide grant money to New Hampshire programs that provide aid and assistance to victims of domestic and sexual violence. Domestic violence grant funds are disbursed by the New Hampshire Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence (Coalition) to twelve (12) local organizations around the state and are used to fund such services as: 24-hour crisis telephone lines, emergency transportation, shelters, community outreach, and education and support services to thousands of victims of sexual and domestic violence each year.

Class 041 - Audit Fund Set Aside per State Requirements.

Area served: Statewide.

Source of Funds: 100% Federal

If Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support the program expenditures.
