

REQUESTED ACTION

1. EXPLANATION

The Residential Substance Abuse Treatment for State Prisoners Formula Grant Program assists states and units of local government in developing and implementing residential substance abuse treatment programs in state and local correctional facilities in which offenders are incarcerated for a sufficient period of time to permit substance abuse treatment. These sub grants support ongoing projects including the Adolescent Drug and Alcohol Program at the Sununu Youth Center, an intensive, multi-phase substance abuse treatment program, and three jail-based substance abuse treatment programs. There are currently three grant years with remaining funds and some of the subgrantees have been


expending prior year awards, leaving the newer awards to be expended, which necessitates extensions.
