REQUESTED ACTION

Approve Jean Ellen Sullivan Trust's request to perform the following work on Lake Winnipesaukee in Moultonborough. File # 2019-01071. This project will not have significant impact on or adversely affect the values of Lake Winnipesaukee.

Install 6 foot x 40 foot seasonal pier, single seasonal boatlift and two personal watercraft lifts 62 feet to the west of an existing 68 linear foot curved breakwater with a 4 foot x 70 foot cantilevered pier on an average of 173 linear feet of frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee on Long Island in Moultonborough.

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

- 1. All work shall be in accordance with revised plans by Watermark Marine Construction revision dated July 10, 2019 and received by the NH Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) on July 10, 2019.
- 2. This permit is not valid and effective until it has been recorded with the appropriate county Registry of Deeds by the applicant. Prior to starting work under this permit, the permittee shall submit a copy of the recorded permit to the NHDES Wetlands Program by certified mail, return receipt requested.
- 3. No work is authorized to the existing 68 linear foot curved breakwater with a 4 foot x 70 foot cantilevered pier.
- 4. All development activities associated with this project shall be conducted in compliance with applicable requirements of RSA 483-B and N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Env-Wq 1400 during and after construction.
- 5. Work shall be carried out in a time and manner to avoid disturbances to migratory waterfowl breeding and nesting areas.
- Appropriate siltation and erosion controls shall be in place prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction, and shall remain until the area is stabilized. Temporary controls shall be removed once the area has been stabilized.
- 7. Appropriate turbidity controls shall be installed prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction such that no turbidity escapes the immediate dredge area and shall remain until suspended particles have settled and water at the work site has returned to normal clarity.
- 8. All excavated material and construction-related debris shall be placed outside of the areas subject to RSA 482-A. Any spoil material deposited within 250 feet of any surface water shall comply with RSA-483-B.
- 9. The permittee's contractor responsible for completion of the work shall use techniques described in the New Hampshire Stormwater Manual, Volume 3, Erosion and Sediment Controls During Construction (December 2008).
- 10. Only those structures shown on the approved plans shall be installed or constructed along this frontage. All portions of the structures, shall be at least 20 feet from the abutting property lines or the imaginary extension of those lines into the water.

- 11. Any subdivision of the property frontage will require removal of a sufficient portion of the docking structures to comply with the dock size and density requirements in effect at the time of the subdivision.
- 12. All seasonal structures shall be removed for the non-boating season.
- 13. No portion of the proposed seasonal pier shall extend more than 40 feet from the shoreline at full lake elevation (Elevation 504.32).

EXPLANATION

The NHDES approved this project on July 25, 2019. The NHDES supported its decision with the following findings:

- 1. This is a major impact project per Administrative Rule Env-Wt 303.02(d), construction of any docking structure adjacent to a breakwater.
- 2. The applicant has provided evidence which demonstrates that this proposal is the alternative with the least adverse impact to areas and environments under the department's jurisdiction per Env-Wt 302.03.
- 3. The applicant has demonstrated by plan and example that each factor listed in Env-Wt 302.04(a) Requirements for Application Evaluation, has been considered in the design of the project.
- 4. The NHDES finds that because the project is not of significant public interest and will not significantly impair the resources of Lake Winnipesaukee a public hearing under RSA 482-A:8 is not required.
- 5. The applicant has an average of 173 linear feet of shoreline frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee in Moultonborough.
- 6. The proposed docking facilities will provide 3 slips as defined per RSA 482-A:2, VIII and therefore meets Rule Env-Wt 402.13.

Application file documents are being forwarded to the Governor and the Executive Council in connection with their consideration of this matter pursuant to RSA 482-A:3,II.(a) as it is a major project in public waters of the state.

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




Project Description: Install a 6ft x 40ft seasonal dock, a seasonal boatlift and two seasonal PWC lifts. No work proposed to existing or previously approved shoreline structures.

The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.

A negative result (no record in our database) does not mean that a sensitive species is not present. Our data can only tell you of known occurrences, based on information gathered by qualified biologists and reported to our office. However, many areas have never been surveyed, or have only been surveyed for certain species. An on-site survey would provide better information on what species and communities are indeed present.


