As you already know the World Hellenic Inter-Parliamentary Association is a registered body in Greece that consists of Members of Parliament, legislators and Senators of Hellenic heritage outside of Greece and Cyprus.

The General Assembly will be hosted by the Hellenic Parliament and the sessions will be held in the Senate Chamber of the Parliament. Taking into account the difficult economic situation in Greece, we are thankful to the Hellenic Parliament for her support to W.H.I.A and members and her essential help in the conduct of the 9th General Assembly.

- a) **Cultural program to Thessaloniki, Macedonia, July 5-7, 2013** hosted by the Interdisciplinary Center for Aristotle Studies (Aristotle University of Thessaloniki). 
