One of the drivers for the shortfalls expected in the overtime, part-time and benefit lines is the timing of the State's bi-weekly payroll processing schedule that places 7 pay periods in the 3 month span of the Continuing Resolution. (This seventh payroll is one of two extra monthly pay periods of our annual 26 pay period cycle, which places three FY 2020 payrolls in the months of August and January 2020.) Additional contributors to the shortfalls, include, ensuring customers at the various Division of Motor Vehicle locations receive services from applicable staffing in as timely a manner as able. In addition, there are expanded business hours for REAL ID transactions only on the second Saturday of each month at certain DMV locations.

Division of State Police (234010 and 234015)

One of the drivers for the shortfalls expected in the overtime, part-time and benefit lines is the timing of the State's bi-weekly payroll processing schedule that places 7 pay periods in the 3 month span of the Continuing Resolution. (This seventh payroll is one of two extra monthly pay periods of our annual 26 pay period cycle, which places three FY 2020 payrolls in the months of

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August and January 2020.) Additional contributors to the shortfalls, include, multiple occurrences this fiscal year that have necessitated law enforcement response by the Division. Furthermore, in order to maintain a reasonable backlog in the State Police Forensic Lab, overtime hours are needed.

Division of Fire Standards Training and EMS (237010)

One of the drivers for the shortfalls expected in the overtime, part-time and benefit lines is the timing of the State's bi-weekly payroll processing schedule that places 7 pay periods in the 3 month span of the Continuing Resolution. (This seventh payroll is one of two extra monthly pay periods of our annual 26 pay period cycle, which places three FY 2020 payrolls in the months of August and January 2020.) Additional contributors to the shortfalls, include, the timing of classes being scheduled considering seasonal components.
