EXPLANATION

The individual who was hired into this temporary position #8T2938 when it was created was placed into full time status. Since then, the employee has been hired into a full time permanent classified position prior to expiration of full time status of this temporary position. In order to maintain continuity of operations, it was decided to fill the position again and keep in the capacity of full time status. During the hiring and setup process, it was not noticed that the full time status designation was due to expire and thus, require authorization to be extended past one year if it was to be kept in a full time status. For this reason, we request retroactive approval to extend the position as full time for one more year.

This position is essential for effective and efficient snowmaking operations on Cannon Mountain as well as construction maintenance efforts needed on an ongoing year round basis.
